



# MISSISSIPPI RIVER CREST FORECASTS

**Mississippi River on the rise.  
Crest currently near or above  
LD5 - Minnesota City (3/17/20).**

***A high degree of uncertainty remains on  
eventual peak levels. Crest timing depends  
on new rainfall. Lower amounts mean  
earlier crests.***

***High confidence levels will be reached  
without additional precipitation.***

***Wet weather in the next few weeks to  
bring crests higher (into the most likely  
range). If upcoming rains exceed current  
expectations, crests could be higher.***
