

More Accumulating Snow Today

Travel Impacts Likely During the PM Commute

Key Messages

- Accumulating snow expected late this morning through the evening today, with impacts likely for the PM commute.
- Most locations are expected to see 1 inch of snow, with higher amounts of 2-4+ inches across northeast Missouri, southeast lowa, and west-central Illinois.
- Winds to remain light under 10 mph, so blowing/drifting snow appears unlikely to occur.






More Accumulating Snow Today

What to Expect

- Snow develops late morning/early PM and ends after the PM commute from west to east.
- Snow will be the dry, fluffy variety
- Brief heavier snowfall rates possible (>0.5" per hour)







Check on road conditions before heading out!









Snow Duration Only 3-6 Hours At Any One Location








