Bids for services include the properties of United Junior Senior High School, United West Elementary and United Intermediate School all outside of Monmouth, Illinois, and the property of United North Elementary located in Alexis, Illinois.

All specifications, necessary forms, and instructions for bidders are available at the Superintendent's Office, located at United Junior-Senior High School, 1905 100th Street, Monmouth, Illinois 61462, or by emailing thomas.hawkins@u304.org.

Sealed bids shall be marked "Snowplowing and Salting Services" and must arrive by mail or in person at the Superintendent's Office by 4:00 p.m. **Wednesday, October 7, 2026.** All bids will be opened and read aloud at that time. Bids will be presented to the Board of Education for consideration at their regularly scheduled meeting held on Thursday, **October 8, 2026, at 6:00 p.m.** at United Junior Senior High School, Monmouth, Illinois.

The Board of Education of United Community Unit School District #304 reserves the sole right to waive any and all informalities on the bidding and reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof.

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

1. All bids submitted are final and must be in a sealed envelope labeled "SNOWPLOWING AND SALTING SERVICES".
2. The absolute deadline for submission of sealed bids is 4:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 7, 2026. All bids will be opened and read aloud at that time. Bids will be presented to the Board of Education for consideration at their regularly scheduled meeting held on Thursday, October 8, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. at United Junior Senior High School, Monmouth, Illinois.
3. Sealed bids should be delivered by mail or in person to the Superintendent's Office, located at United Junior Senior High School, 1905 100th Street, Monmouth, Illinois 61462, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday by the specified deadline.
4. Sealed bids must be submitted on the enclosed Bid Submission Form. In addition, the bidder must provide proof of \$1,000,000 of liability insurance, proof of Worker's Compensation coverage, a list of equipment inventory, and a minimum of two references. Additional documentation may be provided by the bidder as needed or desired.
5. Sealed bids must be submitted for the 2026-2027 winter season, and are on a "per snowplowing and salting" basis for each property.
6. All bidders are to provide proof of Worker's Compensation coverage to comply with the Statute of the State of Illinois with a limit of at least \$500,000 and proof of liability insurance in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000.
7. Bids will be evaluated on a number of criteria, including references, responsibility, and cost, as determined by the Board of Education of United CUSD #304. Retainer bids will not be considered.
8. The Board of Education of United CUSD #304 reserves the sole right to waive any and all informalities on the bidding and reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or any part thereof.

SPECIFICATIONS OF CONTRACT
SNOWPLOWING AND SALTING SERVICES
UNITED COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT #304

The following specifications are required to fulfill the contract:

1. The contractor shall provide all labor and equipment necessary to snowplow and salt the parking lots and driveways on an as needed basis at the sites of United Junior Senior High School located east of Monmouth, Illinois, United West Elementary and United Intermediate School located northwest of Monmouth, Illinois and/or United North Elementary located in Alexis, Illinois.
2. This contract shall commence in the winter of 2026 and terminate at the end of the 2027 winter season. The Board may elect to terminate this contract prior to the end of the original term.
3. Snowplowing shall occur after 1+” of snowfall, and salting in the event of ice accumulation, and shall be completed by 7:15 a.m.
4. Additional plowing or salting for special circumstances or events will be completed at the request of the superintendent or designee.
5. The Contractor is responsible for plowing and salting parking lots and driveways on each property.
6. The district has the option to call the Contractor at any time if plowing and salting has not been adequate.
7. Contractor agrees to indemnify United CUSD #304 from any liability for injuries to himself/herself, his or her employees, any third persons and any property damage incurred by Contractor, or Board, during the performance of the duties relating to the snowplowing and salting services provided. In the event this agreement is terminated by the Board, the Contractor shall be paid for all services properly rendered or performed to the effective date of such termination.
8. Payment for services shall be made to the Contractor on the third Tuesday of each month.
9. The Contractor is performing the services under this agreement as an independent contractor and is not deemed to be an employee of the Board.
10. A Certificate of Insurance must be submitted before a contract will be awarded. The Certificate of Insurance must contain the following:

Worker’s Compensation: To comply with the Statue of the State of Illinois with a limit of at least \$500,000.

Comprehensive General Liability and Property Damage in the amount of: Bodily Injury/Property Damage Occurrence – Minimum \$1,000,000 combined single limit.

11. The Contractor shall purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect him/her from claims under worker's compensation acts and other employee benefit acts, from claims for damages to property which may include death, and from claims for damages to property which may arise out of or result from the Contractor's operations under this contract, whether such operations be by himself/herself or by any subcontractor or anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them. This insurance shall be written for not less than any limits of liability specified as part of this Contract, or required by law, whichever is the greater, and shall include contractual liability insurance as applicable to the contractor's obligations under special conditions.

The Contractor shall also purchase and maintain such insurance as will protect the Owner and their agents and employees from and against all claims, damages, losses and expenses including attorneys' fees arising out of or resulting from the performance of the work, provided that any such claim, damage, loss or expense (1) is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death or death to injury to or destruction of tangible property (other than the work itself) including the loss of use resulting there from, and (2) is caused in whole or part by any negligent act or omission of the Contractor, and Subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by any of them or anyone for whose acts any of them may be liable, regardless of whether or not it is caused in part by a party to whom insurance is afforded pursuant to the paragraph.

This insurance shall be written for not less than any limits of liability specified as part of this contract, or required by law, whichever is the greater. Certificate of such insurance shall be filed with the owner before starting work.

12. The Contractor is responsible for the instructing, supervision, and implementation of all safety rules and regulations. The owner is not responsible for any injuries or loss of life, connected with this project.
13. It shall be the Contractor's responsibility to comply with all local, state and federal laws and regulations governing job safety and health standards, and the requirements of the "Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1970" enacted by Congress and signed into law on December 29, 1980.
